1 Petitioner Howard K. Stern, as Executor under the Will of Vickie Lynn Marshall, aka
2 Vickie Lynn Smith, aka Vickie Lynn Hogan, aka Anna Nicole Smith's *Ex Parte* Application for a
3 Temporary Restraining Order against Respondents Thomas Riccio, Universal Rarities LLC ~~and~~
4 ~~Gerald Wayne Johnson~~ (collectively "Respondents") came on regularly for hearing on July 6,
5 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 5 of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, the Honorable
6 Mitchell L. Beckloff presiding. Bruce S. Ross and Vivian L. Thoreen of Luce, Forward, Hamilton
7 & Scripps, LLP appeared for Petitioner. NO ONE appeared

10 BASED THEREON, and GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE, the Court orders
11 as follows:

12 ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

13 Respondents are ordered to show cause why a Preliminary Injunction should not issue:

14 (1) Enjoining Respondents from selling, distributing or otherwise disseminating, in any
15 manner and any form of media whatsoever, the Videotape(s) at issue and/or its contents;

16 (2) Requiring Respondents to provide Petitioner with a full accounting of the treatment of
17 the Videotape(s) at issue so that Petitioner may be informed as to whether copies have been made
18 and, if so, the current disposition of those copies; and

19 (3) Requiring Respondents to return to Petitioner the Videotape(s) at issue, as well as all
20 copies, excerpts, or other media depicting the Videotape(s) at issue or any portion thereof created
21 by Respondents.

22 A hearing on said Order to Show Cause is set for 7-20, 2007 at ~~8:30 a.m.~~ ^{1:30 p.m.} in
23 Department 5 of this Court.

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

(3) Respondents are ordered to immediately return to Petitioner the Videotape(s) at issue, as well as all copies, excerpts, or other media depicting the Videotape(s) at issue or any portion thereof created by Respondents.
