I retired from the FBI in 2000 and joined The O'Quinn Law Firm. I am also a contract news analyst covering law enforcement, counterterrorism and security issues.

In my capacity with The O'Quinn Law Firm, I have become heavily involved in the Anna Nicole Smith case. The topic of which has prompted me to write this letter to you. We at The O'Quinn Law Firm applaud your efforts to seek an independent investigation into the allegations of impropriety against Judge Larry Seidlin, which should not be overlooked.
