Details:

On 102704 at 1026 hours I was dispatched to 403 E. Fourth St. in Perris, Ca. reference a violation of restraining order. At 1036 hours I spoke to Victim, Yolanda Smith, in the front lobby of the Perris Station.

Yolanda Smith's Statement:

Yolanda explained she has a restraining order against Suspect, Alfred Beardsley, RIC389901. Beardsley had called Yolanda's nephew, Manuel Blanco, about two days ago. Beardsley called, Blanco, by telephone, to have Blanco deliver a message to Yolanda.

Beardsley needed to call Yolanda and her attorney to set up an interview appointment with O.J. Simpson, and to get ready for trial. Blanco told Beardsley not to call him or Yolanda again, that Beardsley was violating the restraining order.

Yolanda is requesting charges be filed against Alfred Beardsley reference violating the restraining order. Yolanda described Beardsley as a white male, age 43 years, DOB:122061, 606, 260, black hair, and blue eyes. Yolanda does not have an address or phone for Beardsley.

I attempted to contact Witness, Manuel Blanco, for a statement for the past three days. Blanco has not returned any of my messages left on his cell phone or home phone. Request this report be forwarded to investigations for follow up interview with Blanco, and to forward this report to the Riverside DA's Office for review and prosecution.
